**4. Staff Liaison Report**

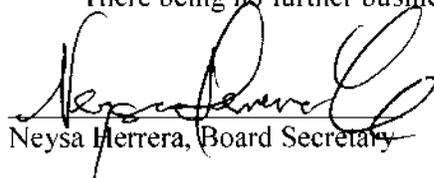

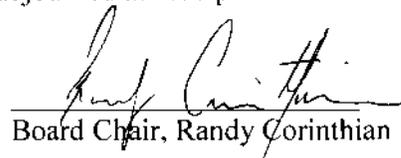
