

LAKESIDE SAND PINE PRESERVE CLEAN UP

This beautiful park boasts over five acres of native sand pine scrub and plants, walkway, elevated decking and educational shelter. It is also home to many Florida native species including the gopher tortoise. Each year, volunteers mount an effort to eliminate invasive species of plant life while maintaining trails and walkways.

Participants should wear comfortable work shoes and clothes that you don't mind getting dirty. No open toe shoes. Please bring gloves, hat and sunscreen. Water, tools and light snack will be provided.
