



When will the water interruption occur?

The Florida Department of Transportation has scheduled a water disconnection on **Tuesday, December 17th between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM.**

How long will the water interruptions last?

About 6 hours, while the FDOT Contractor performs work on the existing water main your water will be shut down.

PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER: A precautionary boil water will be in effect for a minimum of 48 hours after restoration of pressure. The City must obtain satisfactory bacteriological water samples for the next 48 hours prior to rescission of the precautionary boil water notice.

Precautionary Boil Water Notice

As a precaution, the City of Oakland Park, in consultation with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, is issuing a **PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE** for a minimum of 48 hours after restoration of water.

This "Precautionary Boil Water Notice" will remain in effect until bacteriological surveys show that the water is safe to drink.

Residents are advised that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or washing dishes be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

You will be notified once the Boil Water Notice is lifted.
