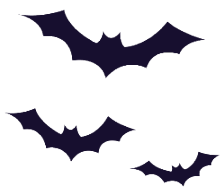

4. No printed literature may be handed out during the event unless pre-approved.
5. No alcoholic beverage permitted.
6. All items must be individually wrapped in sealed manufactured wrapping.
7. No homemade items are allowed to be distributed.
8. If your product contains any type of nuts or peanut butter, please advise so that you may be provided with a sign to make attendees aware.
9. For the safety of everyone, all vehicles must remain in place until the event has ended.
