The City recently instituted a registration process for all short term rentals (AirBNB, Homeaway, etc.) for homes that are not occupied by the owner of the property. Several popular websites no longer print the address of the property until after the unit is rented. In order for us to identify the locations subject to the new regulation, we need to identify these properties. If you know or suspect that a property is being used as a short term rental, please report it to us.
