

TRASH COLLECTION

RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

Residential garbage is collected twice per week (see collection map on p. 38.) Residents are provided a green 96-gallon cart with the following instructions:

- Place garbage carts curbside in the proper location more than three feet from cars, fences, hydrants, etc. by 7 a.m. on designated collection days.
- All regular household refuse and garbage must be in carts.
- All yard waste must be in bags.
- Carts must have lids completely closed.
- Do not place items on top of the carts.
- Do not place construction debris, concrete, sand, dirt, rocks, sod or hot coals inside carts.
- Do not place hazardous waste or biohazardous waste in carts. These items include: Paint, paint thinners and strippers, used oil, automotive fluids and gasoline, solvents, pesticides, fertilizers, pool chemicals, spot removers, oven and drain cleaners, metal polish, tires, rechargeable or automotive batteries or medical waste.

BULK TRASH CURBSIDE COLLECTION

Residential bulk trash must be placed curbside between 7 a.m. Sunday and 7 a.m. Monday of your neighborhood's collection week (refer to map p. 39). Bulk collection may occur on any weekday that week. Unacceptable bulk items and any bulk trash placed out too early will be tagged by Code Enforcement and residents are given two days to remove items.



Acceptable Bulk Items

- Bulk trash items must be at least four feet from fences, solid waste receptacles, poles, hydrants, cars, etc. and not under low hanging tree branches or wires. Separate all bulk yard waste from other bulk items.
- Tree limbs may be up to eight feet in length and less than four inches wide.
- Grass clippings must be in bags.
- Carpeting, rugs and padding cannot exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- Glass must be wrapped in newspaper and placed in secure, weather-proof containers.
- Audio equipment (stereo and speakers).
- Appliances and metal items must be put out separately. Remove doors from appliances and valves from propane tanks.
- Bulk trash must be generated by the occupants of the residence.



Unacceptable Bulk Items

- Household Hazardous Waste or Biohazardous/medical waste (see p. 37 for free drop-off site).
- Construction material or demolition debris (concrete material, cinder blocks, bricks, or lumber), sand, dirt, rocks, sod, or tree stumps.
- Bulk trash generated by non-occupants of the residence.
- Household garbage will not be collected with bulk trash.
- Auto or marine parts (batteries, for tire drop off - see page 37).
- Items left in front of vacant properties.
- Items within four feet of fences, poles, hydrants, cars, refuse carts or under low overhead wires or tree branches.
- All landscape, lawn maintenance and/or tree trimming companies contracted to do work on residential property are responsible for removal of all trimmings and debris.
- Business generated materials.


PLACING UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS IN RECYCLING CARTS CAN RUIN AN ENTIRE LOAD



- Furniture and metal polishes
- Automotive fluids, gasoline and solvents
- Mercury, rechargeable, and auto batteries
- Propane tanks
- Fire extinguishers and flares

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- Bio-hazardous/medical waste
- Explosives
- Business-generated material

- Used oil and oil filters
- Pesticides
- Insecticides
- Fertilizers
- Pool chemicals
- Electronics

Up to four (4) tires can be dropped-off each visit, free of charge, to the City's tire drop-off center. **Tires must first be removed from the rims.**






