Getting Started with Kindle Fire Devices

You can use OverDrive's mobile app to borrow and enjoy eBooks and audiobooks from your library on your Kindle Fire, Fire HD, or Fire HDX.

Step 1:

Download the OverDrive app from one of the following:

Step 2:

Open to OverDrive app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account and log in.

Step 3:

In the OverDrive app, find your library's OverDrive website. On most Kindle Fires, you can do this by tapping the icon in the top-left corner to open the **Home menu**, tapping **Manage libraries**, and then +. On first generation Kindle Fires, tap the  icon (or if you don't have this icon, go to Menu → Get Books).

- Tap the star to save your library to your library list.
- Tap your library's name to start browsing.

Step 4:

Log into your library's OverDrive-powered website with your library card and borrow a book.

Step 4:

Find borrowed books on your **Checkouts** page (under your **Account**) on your library's OverDrive website. You can:

- Download/Add EPUB eBooks* and MP3 audiobooks directly to OverDrive app.
- Select Kindle Books (U.S. only) to complete checkout on Amazon's website and send the book to your Kindle.
- Tap **Read** to open and read OverDrive Read eBooks right in your browser. For the best reading experience, turn off Accelerate page loading.
