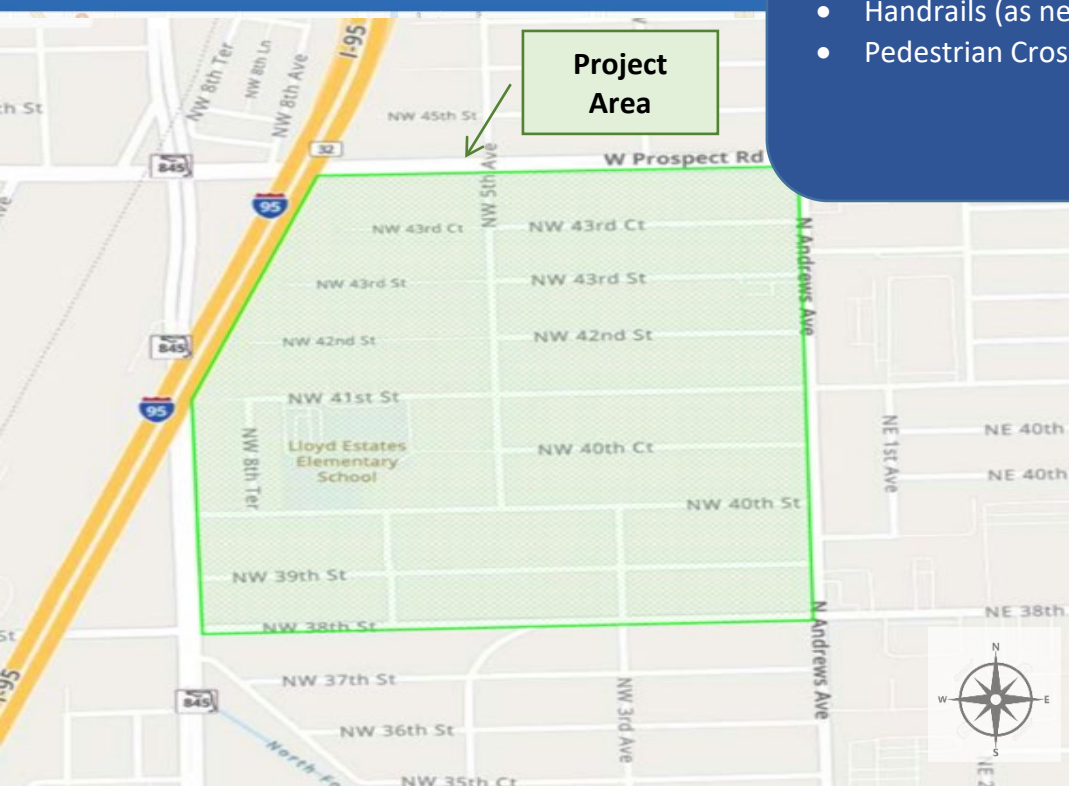
What are the improvements?

Survey and data collection work will begin on February 8, 2021



Areas of Surveying Operations:

From Prospect Road to NW 38th Street/Park Lane West and from I-95/Powerline Road to North Andrews Avenue (See affected area map above).

We ask for your patience during surveying.

While work is being performed in your area, you may temporarily encounter the following:

- Surveyors and other utility locating professionals may be installing markings in the roadway, swale, and near private property. Property access will not be impacted.
- Traffic control measures will be used to ensure public safety. Please follow posted signs and project personnel.
